SUBJECT: RESIDUAL SP WEST PRODUCTIVITY FUND DISTRIBUTION

Disbursement of residual productivity fund account.

Attention Former SP Western Lines Switchmen and Trainmen

Eligible former SP Western Lines Switchmen and Trainmen will receive a distribution from the former SP Western Lines productivity fund account. This distribution will be included with the Union Pacific second half of March 2009 regular payroll check (April 10).

To be eligible a SP Western Lines Switchman/Trainman must have been a crew consist protected employee, who received a ProFund distribution in December 1997 and have maintained a seniority connection with Union Pacific Railroad through January 30, 2009.

This distribution of \$255.90 is considered as wages and therefore is taxable however the wages will not offset any guarantee or protective allowance payments (TPA).

The residual productivity fund account represents the money held in reserve to pay claims on the productivity fund which is now complete.
